



HOUSE RULES

LEAGUE GAMES ARE PLAYED UNDER CURRENT NTSSA INDOOR RULES AND APPLICABLE FIFA LAWS.

ROSTERS

Your official team league roster and the remaining balance of your team fee **MUST** be turned into the facility **BEFORE** the start of your first game. Valid NTSSA Indoor rosters only will be accepted. **IF A ROSTER IS NOT TURNED IN AT THE FIRST GAME THEN A FORFEIT WILL BE GIVEN.** Players can be added up until the start of the 4th game of the season. After that illegal players will cause the offending team to forfeit. No exceptions to this rule will be allowed.

PLAYOFF ELIGIBILITY: All players must participate in at least one regular season game to be eligible to participate with the team in the playoffs.

Over 30 Age Restriction Rule:

You must be over 30 to play in this league.

ID CARDS: Everyone entering the player's box must have a NTSSA ID card. This includes coaches. A coach that is coaching a youth game may use a youth ID card as a coach's card. A coach that is coaching an adult game may **NOT** use a youth ID card as a coach's card. A **MAXIMUM** of two coaches will be allowed in the player's box and they must both have ID cards. Any player who uses another player's ID card in a game will be suspended from play at Frisco Indoor Sports for a **MINIMUM** of one week. The ID card will be confiscated by the scorekeeper or the referee and sent to the NTSSA A&D Committee. **NO CARD...NO PLAY...NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** Your ID card will be given to the referee before the start of the game. Each individual player must hand their ID card to the referee – no stacks, rings or books of cards may be accepted by the referee.

FORMATION OF TEAMS: You may choose any player to play on your team as long as they are the appropriate age

MISCONDUCT: Any player, coach, or spectator may be ejected from the building if any Frisco Indoor Sports staff member or referee feels they are being disruptive.



LEAGUE STANDINGS: Standings are based on the following point system:

- 3 points for each win
- 1 point for each tie
- 0 points for each loss

TIEBREAKERS: Tiebreakers to determine playoff positions at the end of the season are determined by the following:

- Head to Head competition
- Goal Differential
- Goals For
- Goals Against
- Coin Flip

FORFEITS: Teams will receive a 5 minute grace period after scheduled game time before receiving a forfeit. When a forfeit occurs, the opposing team will be awarded a 3-0 win and given 3 points. The team that forfeits will be given a loss and 0 points. The maximum number of players needed to avoid a forfeit is as follows:

2 less than the maximum number

Any team that forfeits without giving 24 hours prior notice may be charged a \$25 forfeit fee.

FIGHTING: NO FIGHTING OF ANY KIND IS ALLOWED. FIRST OFFENSE IS A SUSPENSION FROM THE CURRENT SEASON. ANY PLAYER LEAVING THE BENCH TO JOIN IN A FIGHT WILL RECEIVE THE SAME PENALTY. THE SECOND OFFENSE WILL RESULT IN A LIFETIME SUSPENSION FROM FRISCO INDOOR SPORTS. Any player or spectator ejected from a game must leave the facility immediately.

No food or drinks allowed on the playing field or practice fields.

No chewing gum or tobacco products on the playing field or practice fields.

No spitting allowed on the field or the team bench areas.

Taunting, baiting, or profane language is not allowed. .

No Jewelry

No Running outside of the field

No Climbing.

Children must be supervised at all times.



RULES FOR SMALL-SIDDED INDOOR SOCCER

All players must wear shin guards that are completely covered by socks.
 Teams must wear like colored jerseys with a permanent number.
 Indoor shoes or flats may be worn – NO CLEATS

Special Small-Sided Rules

Small-Sided Restrictions: - Crease Violation

1. Violation by attacker – ball is awarded for goal kick to opponent
2. Violation by defender a Penalty Kick is awarded from center circle – Results in a Goal or a Goal Kick

Can only score from Offensive side of the field

1. The ball must be 100% on the offensive side of field of play.
2. Penalized by awarding the ball to opponents.

All kicks are indirect, except corner and Penalty Kicks.

Ball Size

U5 – U7 will play with a size 3 ball.
 U8 - U12 will use a size 4 ball.
 U13 and older will use a size 5 ball



SPECIAL COED RULES

Each team will field a total of four players: 2 male and 2 female and a goalkeeper of either sex.

The minimum number of players required to start a game is three, one being a female. A team may have more females than males on the field at any time. Similarly, there can be more male players (excluding the goalkeeper). A female may score from anywhere on the field and will receive 2 points for a goal. A male may score from anywhere and is awarded 1 point for a goal – max goals of 3 per game.

There is NO slide tackling in a coed game.
